This qualification reflects the role of people with responsibility for the development and the outcomes of programs and services for young people managed through a range of agencies and designed to meet the social, behavioural, health, welfare, developmental and protection needs of young people. This work may be undertaken through employment in community, government and welfare agencies.

## CAREERS & PATHWAYS

This qualification allows graduates to pursue a career within a number of settings in roles such as Residential Youth Worker or Support Worker. It is suitable for professionals looking to specialise in working with youth through supporting & advocating for young people, and planning & facilitating youth programs. It would also compliment other accreditations for professionals working as Social Workers, Case Managers, Practitioners, Support Workers or similar.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Whilst there are no entry requirements or prerequisites for new entrants into the course, working in the field of youth work requires a person to possess soft skills such as empathy, the ability to suspend judgement and be able to work with people who are culturally or linguistically diverse. The student will be required to obtain their own blue card or equivalent and undergo a police check.

The new learner will discuss their previous experiences and share their attitude towards the sector during pre-enrolment discussions in order that they understand these elements that will assist the acceptance of the concepts and issues trained in the course. Learners with an appropriate approach to the empathy and caring requirements of the youth work role will be processed through to the next step in the enrolment process.

Learners enrolling into the youth work diploma may have limited recent experience in the industry or are looking to pursue a career in the youth work field.

Please note, this course requires the learner to undertake a minimum of 100 hours of placement.
