The CHC40413 Certificate IV in Community Services will provide you with the skills of a community service worker who designs and delivers person-centered services to individuals and/or groups. Workers may provide support, advocacy or interventions to individual clients, groups or communities across a range of services.

At this level, workers may be autonomous with limited responsibility within established parameters and may be required to supervise and lead other workers in projects or teams. Work may take place in a range of community service, case work or case management contexts.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no general entry requirements for this course. ## PRACTICAL PLACEMENT

## DURATION

The completion time frame for this qualification is up to twelve (12) months. Learners who are granted course credit will receive a revised duration once their credit has been processed by Student Services.
