Re: Articulation Arrangements with Griffith University

I am pleased to advise that the relevant Griffith University Dean (Learning and Teaching) has now approved credit articulation arrangements for several of your Diploma programs as listed below.

- Diploma of Child, Youth and Family Intervention – Bachelor of Child and Family Studies & Bachelor of Human Services – 60CP;
- Diploma of Youth Work – Bachelor of Child and Family Studies & Bachelor of Human Services – 60CP;
- Diploma in Community Services – Bachelor of Child and Family Studies & Bachelor of Human Services – 60CP;
- Diploma of Counselling – Bachelor of Psychological Science – 40CP & Bachelor of Counselling 30CP;
- Diploma of Leisure and Health – Bachelor of Sport Development - 30/40CP

Students wishing to study a Bachelor of Social Work will be considered for credit on a case by case basis at time of admission to the program.

Students will be required to meet the standard Griffith University program academic admission criteria. These arrangements will remain current whilst your Institution is approved to deliver the qualification by the Australian Government Department of Education and Training and is listed in the National Register of VET Providers.
